André Goddu received his doctorate in medieval history and the history of science from the University of California, Los Angeles in 1979. He joined Stonehill College in 1990 as a member of the Program in the History of Science, and became a member of the Department of Astronomy and Physics in 2012. He retired from full-time teaching in 2015, and is now Emeritus Professor of Astronomy and Physics.

He has published a book on William of Ockham, and another on Nicholas Copernicus in addition to many journal articles, and he has completed a translation of Ludwik Antoni Birkenmajer's *Mikołaj Kopernik* (1900), currently in press.
