



Andrzej Jajszczyk is Professor at AGH University of Science and Technology in Krakow, Poland. He was a visiting scientist in Australia, Canada, and France.

He served as the founding Director of the National Science Centre, a Polish research funding agency, and was Vice-President of the European Research Council (ERC).

His research has been focused on computer and telecommunications networking. He is the author or co-author of 12 books and over 300 research papers, as well as 19 patents. He also published over 100 papers on research funding and higher education. He is 1998 IEEE Fellow, and a member of Polish Academy of Sciences, Polish Academy of Arts and Sciences, and Academia Europaea. He was the Editor-in-Chief of IEEE Communications Magazine and held other editorial positions.
