

Ovanes Akopyan is Andrew W Mellon Fellow at Villa I Tatti, the Harvard University Center for Italian Renaissance Studies.

He is the author of "Giovanni Pico della Mirandola's Disputationes adversus astrologiam divinatricem and Its Reception" (Brill, 2021) and the editor or co-editor of four collections of essays.

His second monograph, provisionally entitled "Explaining Natural Disasters in Early Modern Europe: Science, Politics, Rhetoric," is under contract with Johns Hopkins University Press.
